Greetings from **Karen Kohler** and **Fin Alley Arts Management!** I'm writing with news of recent successes, upcoming plans and an appeal for your support.

2005 was fruitful indeed! My third album, *The Moons of Venus: Romancing Marlene Dietrich*, was released in Dietrich's hometown of Berlin. in June. In addition to the Berlin concerts, singing highlights included a renovated train depot in Munich, the German Embassy in Washington, D.C. and Texas Christian University, where I also conducted a master class.

Here in New York, I debuted two new shows with KT Sullivan: *Speak Low: The Love Songs of Lenya and Weill* and *A Marvelous Party: A Toast to Noel Coward,* chosen as "Best Revue" of 2005 by the Manhattan Association of Cabarets and Clubs. In September, I was featured on the cover of *Cabaret Scenes* magazine along with an article describing my life as performer, producer, director, and leader of the European ensemble, the Kabarett Kollektif, which in February won the 2006 Nightlife Award for "Unique Cabaret Performance."

I am proud of these successes, which could not have happened without your enthusiasm and unbelievable support!

As a soloist, I am committed to two exciting new projects for the coming year: **Jam and Spice: The Songs of Kurt Weill** and **Little Death: Songs of Coming and Going.**

Jam and Spice is the concert version, with an 11-member cabaret orchestra, of my tribute to Kurt Weill (and the title of my second album). Little Death will bring all my musical influences — classical, cabaret, jazz, blues and gospel — together in one program for the first time and will feature a new quartet.

In the case of both projects, funding is needed for musicians' and arrangers' fees, publicity, and rental of a cabaret/theater venue large enough to accommodate us. The total estimated costs to mount each project for four (4) nights at a suitable venue in New York is \$13,000 for *Jam and Spice* and \$5,000 for *Little Death*.
